

Barbaresco DOCG Mondino

The vineyard is located in the Balluri area of Neive, on the hill after which the wine is named (Bricco Mondino). Barbaresco DOCG Mondino is the most open, fruity Barbaresco, with delicate tannins. The first to leave the cellar: a perfect wine for those who are approaching this historic red for the first time.

GRAPE

Variety: 100% Nebbiolo Vine training system: Guyot

VINIFICATION

Temperature controlled fermentation and maceration in steel tanks (28-30°C)

Ageing: in large barrels (for a minimum of 18 months) Bottle-aged for at least six months

WINE CHARACTERISTICS

Deep ruby red, with intense scents of red berry fruits. Evolved, silky tannins. Structured, elegant body.

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
